

Application Portal Norway

It is now possible to apply for a visa and residence permit on the Internet. The pilot project applies only to applications submitted to the Norwegian embassies in Manila and Teheran, and to the Police in Drammen and Stavanger. The Service Centre for Foreign Workers in Stavanger is also included in the pilot project. Application on the Internet started as a pilot project 8th February 2010.

What is Application Portal Norway?

Application Portal Norway enables applicants to apply for a visa, residence permit and Norwegian citizenship on the Internet.

The pilot project comprises residence permit applications (for work, au pair, study and family immigration) and visa applications submitted at the Norwegian Embassies in Manila and Teheran. The new electronic solution has been developed to provide better services for the applicants. Application Portal Norway has already been introduced in London, Kiev, Moscow, Murmansk, St. Petersburg, Baku, Hanoi, Manila and Bangkok. Application on Norwegian nationality will also be available by the Internet in the autumn.

The reference person in Norway may also use the Application Portal Norway. However, the applicant is the responsible part for the application. The application is formally registered on the date that the applicant is interviewed at the Police or the Norwegian Embassy.

Application Portal Norway will be developed further in the spring and gradually implemented in the whole immigration administration from October 2010.



Why register yourself on Application Portal Norway?

There are several advantages of applying through the Application Portal Norway:

- apply independently of the opening hours
- make an online appointment to deliver relevant documents to the police or an embassy
- avoid having to wait in line at the police or embassy
- pay the application fee online.

How to register on Application Portal Norway?

Application Portal Norway has been developed internally by the Directorate of Immigration through the EFFEKT-programme. The program is a collaboration between the Directorate of Immigration (UDI), the Immigration Appeals Board (UNE), the Directorate of Integration and Diversity (IMDi), the Police and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs with the embassies and consulates.

Application Portal Norway will be developed further in the spring. Thereafter it will be implemented throughout the rest of the immigration administration for all type of application, from October 2010.
