

Check list for applications for au pair permits

- A passport photo/photo that meets specific requirements
- Documentation that you have paid an application fee
- A copy of your passport. If you apply from Norway, the date when you entered Norway must be shown in your passport or in other documentation.
- UDI's standard employment contract, signed by yourself and your host family
- The form '[Important information to au pairs and their host families about rights and obligations](#)', signed by yourself and your host family
- An insurance certificate proving that you are guaranteed return travel in the event of illness, injury or death for the whole period you work as an au pair in Norway
- Documentation of the nationality of the host family (e.g. copies of their passports)
- Documentation that you have had legal residence in the country that you applied from for the past six months if you applied from a country other than your home country
- If the host family is a single-parent family, you must document the single parent's percentage responsibility for care and control of the child/children
- A translation of the documents into Norwegian or English
- A written authorisation for your host family if you so wish
