

# Solemn declaration on family relation for use in connection with entry to Norway

The form can be printed and completed by the person living in Norway who wants a visit from his or her grandparents, step-children, step-parents, step-grandparents or step-grandchildren

A photocopy or printout of the completed and signed form can be presented at the point of entry.

If the non-Norwegian relative who wants to enter Norway cannot present a correctly completed form at entry, the person can be refused entry at the border.

This solemn declaration is made by the following person who confirms the correctness of the information provided by his or her signature.

- Registration of the information required in this form is mandatory for the processing of any visa application, and all personal information about me will be sent to and processed by the relevant authorities to decide my visa application.<sup>2</sup>
- The information can also be used in a deportation case
