



# Solemn declaration on relationship for use in connection with entry to Norway

The form can be completed by the person living in Norway who wants a visit from his or her boyfriend/girlfriend.

A photocopy or printout of the completed and signed form can be presented at the point of entry.

If the non-Norwegian relative who wants to enter Norway cannot present a correctly completed form at entry, the person can be refused entry at the border.

This solemn declaration is made by the following person who confirms the correctness of the information provided by his or her signature.

I also declare that our relationship has been based on at least one meeting in person and not only on written, telephone or other e-communication and that the purpose of this person's entry into Norway is to visit/accompany me.

Finally, I declare that the person is familiar with, and will follow, the current requirements for quarantine that apply when entering Norway.

I am aware that information from this statement may be used by the police and that incorrect information may result in my family member being denied entry and sanctioned with punishment.<sup>1</sup>

I understand and agree to the following:

- Registration of the information required in this form is mandatory for the processing of any visa application, and all personal information about me will be sent to and processed by the relevant authorities to decide my visa application.<sup>2</sup>
- The information can also be used in a deportation case.
