

Are you pregnant and seeking asylum?

Information if you are pregnant and applying for protection in Norway



If you are pregnant

You have the right to free follow-up from a regular GP (fastlege) and a midwife where you live.

When you have given birth

You have to register your baby. Children born in Norway are not automatically given a residence permit or Norwegian citizenship.

- If you live in a reception centre, you have to submit the confirmation of the birth you received at the hospital to the people working at the reception centre. The reception centre will send this to the UDI's regional office, and the UDI will then register an application for the child.
- If you do not live in a reception centre, you must go to the police where you live and submit the confirmation of the birth you received at the hospital. The police will then register an application for the child.

All children born in Norway have the right to be followed-up in a public health centre.
