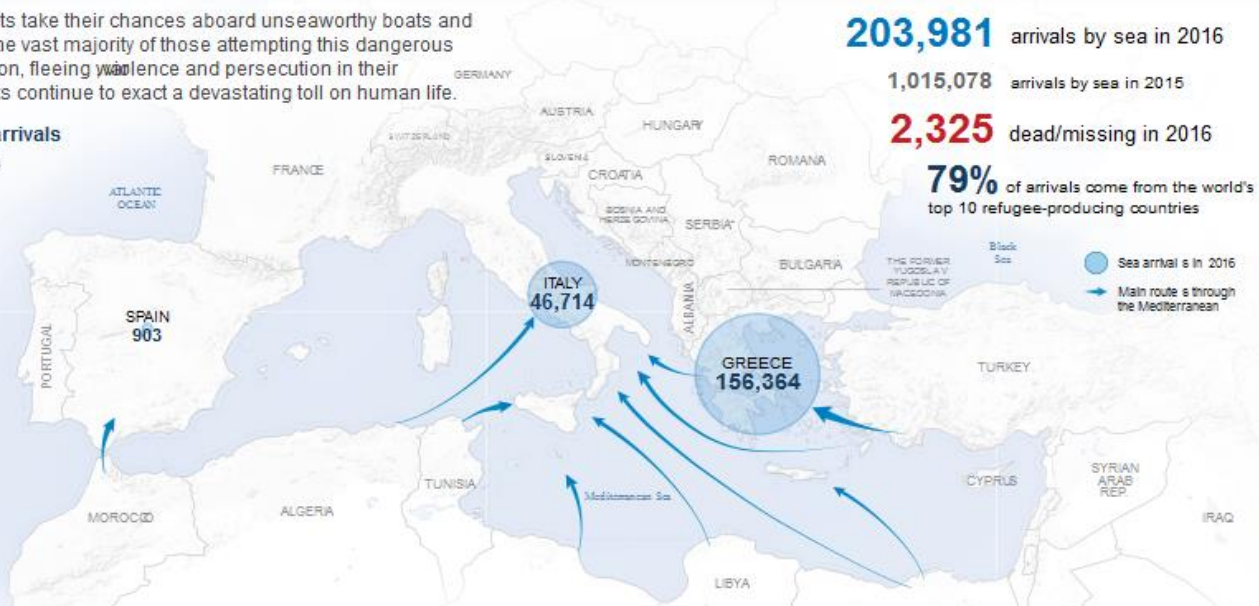
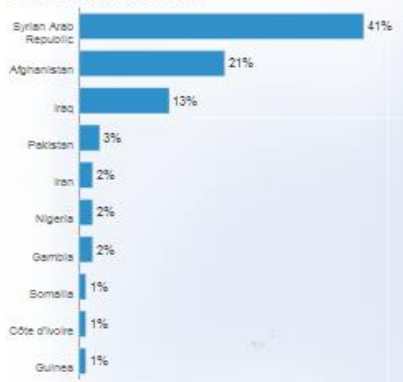


Central Mediterranean Route

Top-10 nationalities of Mediterranean sea arrivals

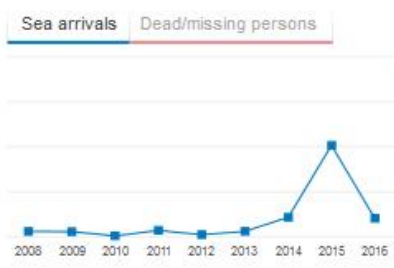
Top-10 nationalities represent 89% of the sea arrivals based on arrivals since 1 Jan 2016



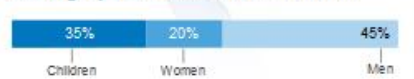
Comparison of monthly Mediterranean sea arrivals
