

Assisted return for people who fall under the Dublin system

If it has been decided that you will be transferred to another country, you must return to that country, which will consider your application for protection.

If you wish, you can choose to return to your home country instead. In such case, you can apply for support to return home and start a new life there.

You can receive

- help to obtain a passport and travel documents
- a plane ticket
- advice from the International Organization for Migration (IOM) in Norway
- NOK 7,000 if you are over the age of 18
- NOK 2,000 if you are under the age of 18 when you apply for assisted return.

This does not apply if you have residence in a European country or certain other countries; see udi.no for more information.

You have to go soon

Short deadlines apply for returning to the European country where your application will be considered. If you would rather return to your home country, you must therefore act quickly to obtain a travel document and go home. You will be given a deadline when you apply to the IOM for assisted return.
