Guarantee form for residence in a family immigration case

You must fill in this form if you are going to provide a financial guarantee in a case where you are not the reference person (third person guarantee), for example if you have a stepchild or parent-in-law who is going to move to Norway.

It is not possible to provide a financial guarantee in a case where someone is moving to Norway to live with their spouse, cohabitant or fiancé. In such cases, the reference person must fulfil the income requirement him/herself and we will retrieve information regarding the income of the reference person from the Tax authorities.

- I declare that I accept financial responsibility for the applicant mentioned above.
- I declare that I will cover the applicant's expenses for their return journey, if he or she is granted a residence permit which is valid for one year or less, and which cannot be renewed. If the applicant is deported from Norway by the police, I declare that I will cover all expenses for up to three escorts.
- I understand that I might incur debts to the State if I do not fulfil my duties as mentioned above, The debts can be collected according to the normal rules regarding enforcement.¹
- I understand that other public agencies can get access to this guarantee form.
- I have attached documentation of my income (employment contract, the last three pay slips and the last tax assessment notice).
- I have attached a copy of my bank card/drivers licence/passport which confirms my identity.
